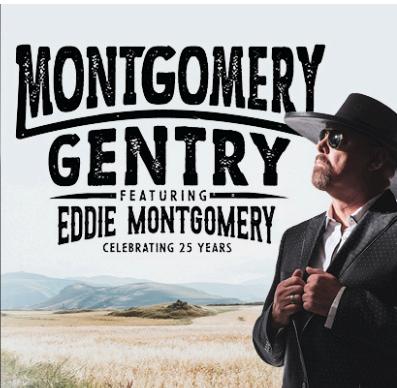
Upcoming Seneca Elder Events

Please abide by the following guidelines for concert tickets:

- a. Sign-up Sheets are posted at each AOA site near the Front Desk **30 days prior** to the show
- b. Sign-ups are collected **2 weeks prior** to the scheduled event
- c. A 'confirmation call' will be made to you to ensure you are still able to attend
- d. **3-4 days** before the event, Elders will be texted specifying the date and location to distribute the tickets to the Elders. The tickets for the Alleg. Elders will be distributed at the Alleg. AOA office, the tickets for the Catt. Elders will be distributed at the Catt. AOA office
- e. **'Guest Tickets'** (aka '**+1 Tickets**') are made available only after sign-ups are tallied and there are leftover tickets – in this case, your guest will be required to pay the cost at either AOA site one week prior to the scheduled event.

FARMERS MARKET COUPONS !

Starting **07/10/2025**, coupon booklets may be picked up at the **Allegany Elder Center** or the **Wini-Kettle Senior Center**.

Eligibility:

- 60 Years of Age or older; AND
- Monthly income is at or below:
 - \$2,413/month (One-Person Household)
 - \$3,261/month (two-Person Household; or
 - \$4,109/Month (three-Person Household)

Rules:

- Proxies may pick-up vouchers on behalf of Elder provided Elder has signed a statement designating that individual as proxy. (*Available at the AOA*)
- A valid Power of Attorney may sign for checks and pick up books on behalf of an Elder.
- Booklet of five (5) \$5.00 checks worth \$25.00.
- For use at authorized vendors and farm stands participating in the program, and not at grocery stores.
- Used to buy locally grown fresh fruits and vegetables.
- Look for the brightly colored Farmers Market sign saying "We Gladly Accept Farmers' Market Checks".
- Checks cannot be used after 11/30/2025.
- Checks are worth \$5.00. Farmers will not give change.
- Coupons may be redeemed by caregivers.

August 2025: Memory Changes



SENECA NATION
HEALTH SYSTEM

Forgetfulness vs. Dementia:

- Forgetfulness can be a normal part of aging. However, dementia is **NOT** a normal part of aging.
- Dementia includes the loss of cognitive functioning – thinking, remembering, learning, and reasoning – and behavioral abilities to the extent that it interferes with a person's quality of life and activities.
- Memory loss, though common, is not the only sign of dementia. People with dementia may also have problems with language skills, visual perception, or paying attention. Some people experience personality changes.

Other conditions that may cause difficulty with memory:

- Sleep Apnea (low oxygen)
- Traumatic Brain Injury, Stroke, or Aneurysm
- Carbon Monoxide Poisoning
- Infections
- Nonmedical Drug Use
- Stress, Witnessing Traumatic Events, and Depression
- Normal Process of Aging

What can be done?:

- Manage both physical and mental health conditions. Stay physically and mentally active.
- Discuss **ANY** concerns with your doctor.

Helpful Reminder:

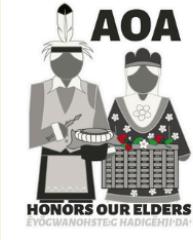

Financial Fraud & Scams



Millions of older Americans lose money to financial fraud and scams each year. Scammers will try to contact you in person, on the phone, through the computer, radio, TV ads, email, and text. They often pressure you to act quickly. But YOU have the power to stop these scammers and the right to say “NO”.

Five of the most common scams affecting older Americans are:



Online Shopping

Scammers pretend to be a real business, but have a fake website or a fake ad on a genuine retailer site.

Tip



Only click on links you searched for



Business Imposters

Scammers send emails or texts pretending to be a major retailer to get your money or personal information.

Tip



Don't click on links in texts or emails before checking your account or contacting the company



Tech Support

Scammers pose as tech support and offer to fix computer problems that are not real. They ask you to give them access to your computer and steal your personal information.

Tip



Accept tech support help only when you noticed a problem and you hired someone or asked for help

Financial Fraud & Scams



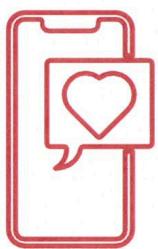
Government Impersonation

Scammers pose as government employees and threaten to arrest or prosecute you unless you agree to pay them.

Tip



The federal government will never call you on the phone and ask for personal information or threaten you



Romance Scams

Scammers pose as interested romantic partners and convince you to give them money or offer to send you money in order to steal your personal information.

Tip



Do not send or receive money in any form (like gift cards or wire transfers) from anyone you have met online, no matter how sad or convincing their story

One of the best ways to avoid financial fraud is to know the scams.

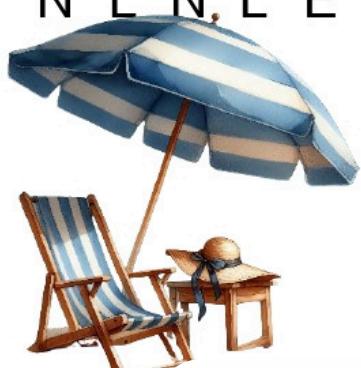
