

Reminder: Entertainment Guidelines

Sign-up sheets for shows will be available 1 MONTH prior to the event. Numbers are turned in to the Casino 1 week prior, if you have a change in plans please cancel before then. Be sure you will be attending when you sign-up as there has been an increase of last-minute cancellations, resulting in a waste of Elder entertainment funds for the remainder of the year. On average we have at least 4 unused tickets per event at an average cost of \$47/ticket that's \$188 per show that is being wasted. Please be mindful of this when you sign-up. Nya:weh!

FARMERS MARKET COUPONS!

Starting 07/18/2022 coupon booklets may be picked up at the Allegany Elder Center or the Wini-Kettle Senior Center.

Coupons may also be requested on-line at https://form.jotform.com/SNAOA/2022SFMNP

Eligibility:

- 60 Years of Age or older; AND
- Monthly income is at or below:
 - \$2,096/month (One-Person Household
 - \$2,823/month (two-Person Household; or
 - \$3,551/Month (three-Person Household

Rules:

- Proxies may pick-up vouchers on behalf of Elder provided Elder has signed a statement designating that individual as proxy.
- A valid Power of Attorney may sign for checks and pick up books on behalf of an Elder.
- Booklet of five (5) \$5.00 checks worth \$25.00.
- For use at authorized vendors and farm stands participating in the program, and not at grocery stores.
- Used to buy locally grown fresh fruits and vegetables.
- Look for the brightly colored Farmers Market sign saying "We Gladly Accept Farmers' Market Checks".
- Checks cannot be used after 11/30/2022.
- Checks are worth \$5.00. Farmers will not give change.
- Coupons may be redeemed by caregivers.

- 8. Do not share medical or personal information including your Social Security number over the phone or computer.
- **9.** Delete unsolicited emails or text messages without clicking on any links.
- **IO.** Never give personal information unless YOU made the call.
