**FY 2025 NET MONTHLY INCOME STANDARDS**

**Effective October 1, 2024 to September 30, 2025**

The net monthly income standard for each household size is the sum of the applicable Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) net monthly income standard and the applicable SNAP standard deduction.
