Title: Public Notice Concerning Indian Community Development Block Grant Imminent Threat Program American Rescue Plan Act (ICDBG-ARP)

Description:

The Seneca Nation Housing Authority (SNHA) with support from the Seneca Nation (SN) will be applying for the Indian Community Development Block Grant Imminent Threat Program American Rescue Plan Act. (ICDBG-ARP)

On March 11, 2021, the President signed the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARP) (Public Law 117-2), which provides additional funding to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the COVID-19 pandemic. ARP included \$280 million for the ICDBG program. This funding will be used to provide ICDBG Imminent Treat grants to Indian tribes to eliminate or lessen problems that pose an imminent threat to public health or safety of Tribal residents.

The ICDBG-ARP Implementation Notice, PIH Notice 2021-22, was published on July 20, 2021 to provide Indian tribes with instructions on how to apply for ICDBG-ARP grants for projects intended to prevent, prepare for, and respond to COVID-19.

The Seneca Nation Budget and Finance Committee will discuss the SNHA ICDBG ARP proposal at the Seneca Nation Budget and Finance Meeting on August 24, 2021.
