Dear 438, Versailles Plank and S. Sulphur Springs Residents,

At the March 10th Council Session, the Seneca Nation Council approved a plan to expand the current natural gas distribution system by installing a natural gas pipeline along Route 438. This pipeline will allow residents on or close to Route 438 (from the Bucktown interconnect to Gowanda), S. Sulphur Springs and Versailles Plank residents the opportunity to switch to natural gas from propane, which would result in significant savings for affected residents. Installation of the 438 pipeline will begin in the near future.

The second purpose of this letter is to confirm the number of residences located along the expansion route that would like to be connected to the new pipeline. Seneca Nation Utilities will cover the cost of the main pipeline as well as the cost of a new service connection up to 200 feet from the road. We ask that you please notify the Natural Gas Department as soon as possible upon receipt of this letter if you would like to be part of the new natural gas line installation, as the residential service lines will be installed concurrently with the main line installation. This project is an important step towards the goal of repairing and expanding natural gas service throughout the Cattaraugus Territory. We are committed to the safe delivery of natural gas to residents while doing our best to preserve the environment. All customers will be subject to Seneca Nation natural gas policies.
