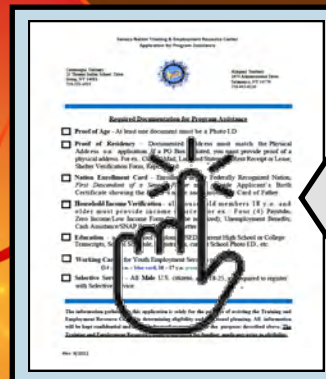

"From June 1, 2022, through July 29, 2022, I worked under the supervision of Seneca Nation Emergency Management Director Mike Gates. I also worked with a summer intern. This internship showed a small glimpse of what it would be like to work in an Emergency Management Department. I was given tasks and projects that emergency managers would be expected to complete. The director also showed me scenarios of what directors/supervisors must deal with on a daily basis. This internship taught me how to work independently on projects while providing periodic updates to the director. I also learned how to collaborate with others on specific projects. Working with others allowed me to see other people's perspectives along with being able to give and receive constructive feedback.

Overall, I really enjoyed my time working in the Emergency Management Department. After seeing all the moving parts of being an Emergency Manager, I can definitely see myself doing this job in the future. The skills I have both learned this summer and what I will learn in my educational career as a geology student will create the skills to become a well-rounded Emergency Manager."

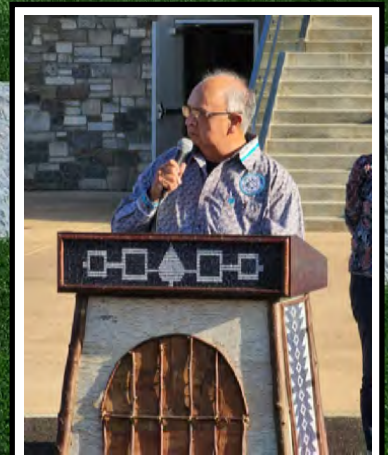


HSED Graduation

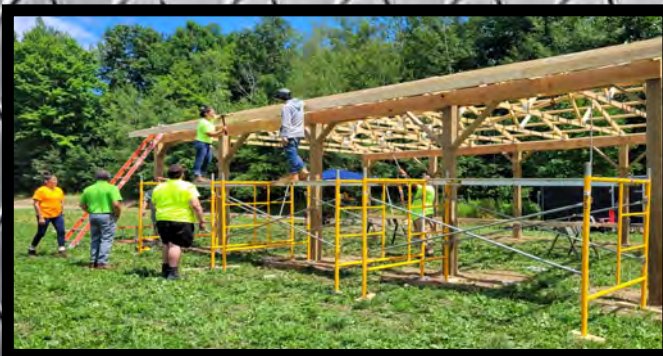
