

- Are you enrolled in a state or federally recognized tribe?
- Do you live on Seneca Nation Territory or within a 20 mile radius of SNI Territories?
 (Allegany, Buffalo Creek, Cattaraugus, Niagara Falls, Oil Springs)
- o Do you have proof of your disability?
- Are you unemployed and want to work?
- o Do you face barriers to finding a job?

If you answered yes, you may be eligible for services.

TERC offers a FREE High School Equivalency program all year long. Learn and review high school level academics to prepare and pass the GED exam. Upon successful completion of this program students receive a NYS High School Equivalency diploma. The Adult Education program strives to offer options that meet the individual needs and learning styles of each student. These options will help you reach your goal of attaining a high school equivalency diploma that will lead to future opportunities for career and academic success. Prior passing scores on the TASC Test™, from 2013-2021 will be transferable to the GED subtest requirements.
