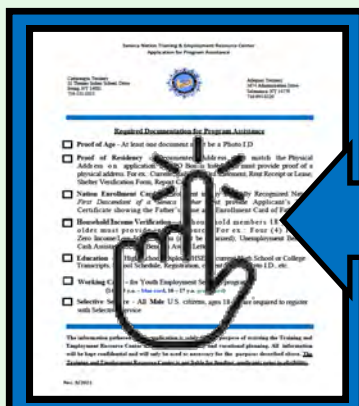

The Vocational Rehabilitation Program

Provides culturally appropriate services that will empower individuals to be successful despite having a documented disability. We will assist you as you work through your individual plan for employment (IPE) that is geared toward your unique interests and skills. During this process you will receive training and services to make you successful.

Program Offerings

- o Employment Discovery & Customization
- o Adult Work Experience & Job Placement
- o Vocational and other training services including books, tools and other training material
- o Transition services
 - >From school to work
 - >Trainings that lead to employment
- o Career Readiness
- o Youth Career Exploration and Employment Services
- o Culturally relevant classes and information

How do I know if I'm eligible?

- o Are you enrolled in a state or federally recognized tribe?
- o Do you live on Seneca Nation Territory or within a 20 mile radius of SNI Territories? (Allegany, Buffalo Creek, Cattaraugus, Niagara Falls, Oil Springs)
- o Do you have proof of your disability?
- o Are you unemployed and want to work?
- o Do you face barriers to finding a job?

If you answered yes, you may be eligible for services.

Prior passing scores on the TASC Test™, from 2013-2021 will be transferable to the GED subtest requirements.
