



If you want to work this summer, applications will be available starting May 1st at the Training & Employment offices so START GETTING YOUR WORKING CARD NOW!

Getting a working card from your high school office will require a PHYSICAL EXAM within the past year!

If you played sports in the past year, you can have the school nurse complete the Physical Exam form! Otherwise, you would have your doctor complete it then return it to the high school office.

Once the high school office has that, then the student must sign in front of school staff.




