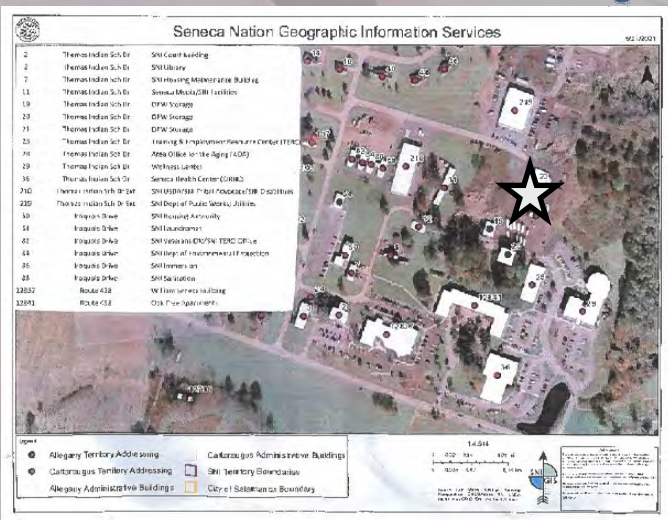




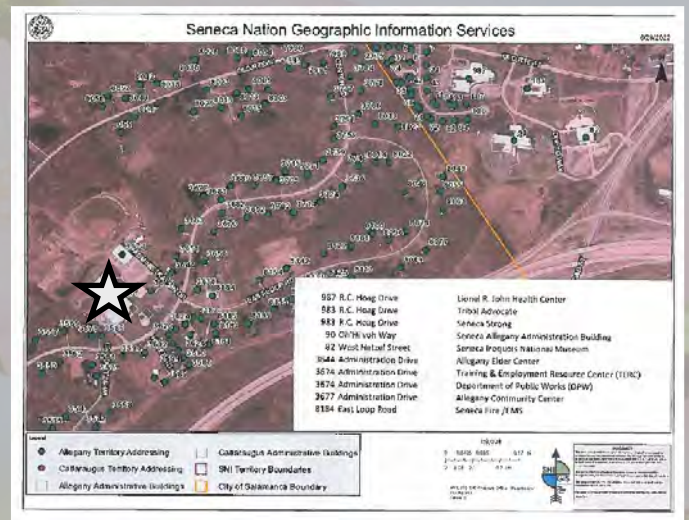

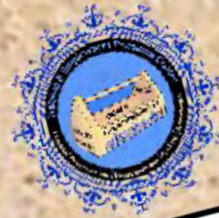

Cake Walk/Social



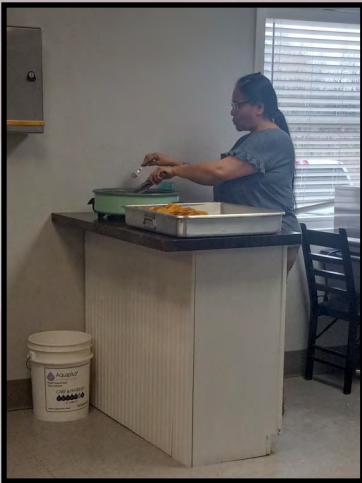

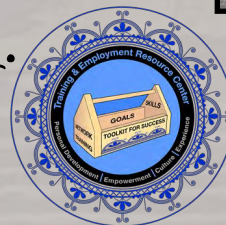
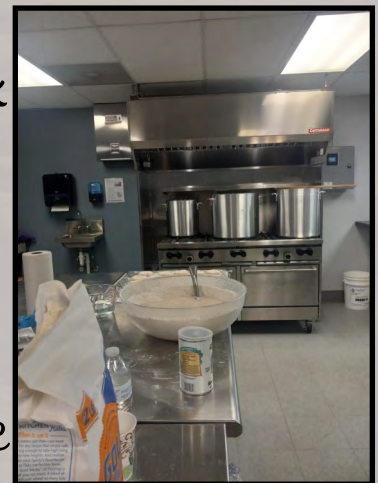
Lunch Time!

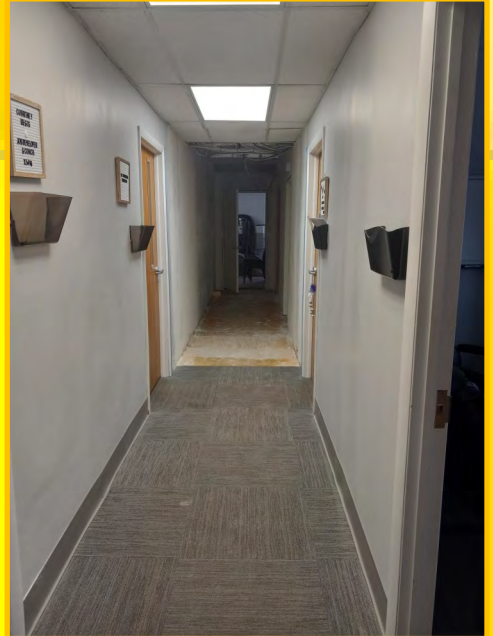
