Purpose

The purpose of the Seneca Nation Health System Board (SNHSB) is to provide overall policy and direction for the Nation's Health System. The Board is also established for the purpose of maintaining overall responsibility for the conduct of the Nation's Health System consistent with its' Charter and specific direction provided from the Nation's Council.

Mission

The Mission of the Board is to ensure that the SNHS provides a comprehensive range of public health services that address the holistic wellness of Seneca people and ensures the health and wellness of the next seven generations of Seneca people.

Qualifications of Commissioners

- Each Board member may or may not be an enrolled member of the Nation;
- Board members shall be at least 25 years of age;
- Board members shall have relevant experience, knowledge and/or education in the health care operations/systems, health care delivery, or public health practice that will enable them to effectively serve in their role;
- At least one credentialed medical professional;
- At least two community members and active users of the SNHS, one of which shall be from the Allegany Territory and one from the Cattaraugus Territory;
- At least two persons with verifiable experience, knowledge, and/or education in healthcare systems and operations or any related or critical functions of healthcare, or public health experience.
- Board members shall have passed a background check by the Nation's Human Resource Department.
- The following persons are **not** eligible to serve on the SNHB;
 - Employees of the SNHS;
 - Owners or employees of contractors providing goods or services to the SNHS (medical or otherwise);
 - o Persons directly related to any of the above;
 - o Persons convicted of a crime of moral turpitude, including but not limited to embezzlement, theft, or fraud;
- Board Members shall be considered "Public Officials" for purposes of the Nation's Ethics Law.
