Pursuant to Section X of the Constitution of the Seneca Nation, every member of the age of eighteen (18) years and upwards, who shall not have been convicted of a felony, shall be competent to vote at all elections and shall be eligible for any office.

Pursuant to Section I of the Constitution of the Seneca Nation, on or before the 15<sup>th</sup> day preceding the biennial election, all candidates shall file with the Clerk of the Nation their name and office, and no further candidate shall be allowed to file for office after the 15<sup>th</sup> day preceding the biennial election. Therefore, all candidates must file with the Clerk at the William Seneca Administration Building, Cattaraugus Territory, no later than 12:00 midnight on Monday, October 20, 2025.
