

### Constitutional Reform Efforts Since 2019

- October 2019:** Council appointed a constitutional reform committee to prepare amendments to the Constitution.
- January 2023:** President Rickey L. Armstrong issued an Executive Order creating a Constitutional Amendment Committee. The Constitutional Amendment Committee returned recommended amendments for the Council to consider.
- September 2024:** Council appointed a three-person constitutional reform committee to prepare amendments to the Constitution.
- October 2024:** The three-person committee returned one recommended amendment to the Constitution; lowering the voting age to 18. Council scheduled the referendum to coincide with the General Election held on November 5, 2024.
- November 2024:** Council acknowledged the results of the referendum, which passed by a vote of 890 in favor to 451 opposed.
- January 2025:** President J. Conrad Seneca issued an Executive Order creating a Constitutional Reform Working Group.
- September 2025:** Council appointed a three-person committee to prepare amendments to the Constitution.
- October 2025:** The three-person committee returned five recommended amendments to the Constitution. Council scheduled the referendum to be held on March 24, 2026.
