

# WELCOME TO THE SULLY

The "Sully" as we call it, is a one stop shop for Seneca language and cultural knowledge.

As an Indigenous knowledge-learning center we look to preserve, protect and revitalize traditional knowledge systems that our Seneca ancestors practiced.

We offer a variety of programming in the areas of language, cultural life ways, agriculture, cultural arts, history and traditional ceremonial knowledge. We provide this programming in the form of Afterschool and summer programming for children, artist workshops, speaker series, lectures, film showings and special events.

Some of the activities we have offered in the past include basket making, pottery classes, woodworking, beading, leather working, textile weaving, planting and foraging processes, medicine and plant identification and language learning. We have had speaker series with artists and authors, environmental agencies. Workshops on storytelling and singing and dancing and family meal preps.

Significant resources that are available include a wood shop, a pottery room with turning wheels and kilns, a sewing room, a maker's space for learning printmaking and textiles. We also have an extensive catalog of Seneca language material including books, dictionaries, songs and learning materials.

Our staff has also proudly represented the Seneca Nation and the Sully Center by providing programming for local schools, outside agencies and government in the form of presentations and workshops on Singing and Dancing, History, Ceremonial Structure and material culture.

We look forward to seeing you here in the Sully.

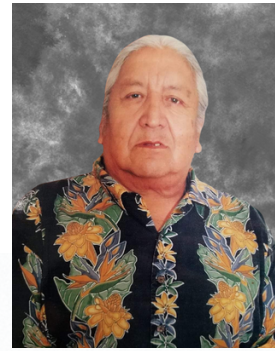
