

**SENECA NATION FALL FESTIVAL 2014
ART SHOW OFFICIAL RULES**

Entries will be accepted at the *Early Childhood Learning Center (ECLC)*, located next to the Saylor Building, at 12857 Route 438, on the Cattaraugus Territory, Irving, New York on Thursday, September 11th from 4-6pm and on Friday, September 12th 9am until 12:00 (NOON) and the judging will begin promptly at 12:15 pm. A preview and artist reception will be held Friday evening from 7:30-9:00pm.

Official Rules:

Entries: Must be created by a Haudenosaunee Artist; ID required upon request.
Work must reflect an aspect of Haudenosaunee tradition or contemporary life and should be done in a style reflecting **Haudenosaunee cultural heritage.**

- ~Nature
- ~Culture/People
- ~Political/Social Issues

***Items deemed Sacred by the Committee will not be accepted for display or competition such as Masks and Turtle Rattles, and depictions thereof.

Quantity: Artists may submit up to three (3) works for competition.
Artists may submit up to (3) additional works for sale and/or display.

Qualifications: Entries must be recent original work not previously entered in this show.
Work must be delivered intact, labeled, and with a completed entry form.
Work delivered by persons other than the artist will not be accepted without a signed and completed entry form by the original artist.

Entries may not be withdrawn before the close of the show at 5:00 pm Sunday, September 14, 2014. Entries must be picked up between 5:00 – 6:00 pm on Sunday.

Sales are encouraged but not mandatory. A sales commission of 10% will be charged on all sales. Payment will be made to the Seneca Nation Fall Festival Committee, which will then pay the artist at the end of the show on Sunday. The Seneca Nation Fall Festival Committee will provide security for the Art Show on the premises, however, we cannot be responsible for items left or damaged by mail/delivery service or items not picked up at the end of the show. *We look forward to your participation in this year's show!!*

4. Woodworking (snowsnakes, lacrosse sticks, utensils, bowls, etc.)
5. Basket making (splint, bark, quill)

7. Contemporary Craft (pottery, glass, metal, mixed media and other 3-dimensional artwork)
8. Black and White Photography
