Session 1: History of WNY NSC & WVDP

From 1966-1972 WNY NSC reprocessed spent fuel rods from commercial nuclear reactors. NYSERDA regained control of site and 1980 Act of Congress brought DOE to site. From 1996-2002, vitrification of 600,000 gal of high-level waste was completed.

Session 2: Current activities by WVDP

Decontamination and demolition activities alongside management of legacy waste is occurring while HLW canisters are moved into interim storage.
