The Board of Regents approved regulations establishing multiple, comparably rigorous assessment pathways to graduation for all students. The recently approved regulations recognize the importance of engaging students' interests in rigorous and relevant academic programs. Under the new "4+1" pathway assessment option, students must take and pass four required Regents Exams or Department-approved alternative assessments (one in each of the following subjects: English, math, science, and social studies) and a comparably rigorous assessment for the fifth required exam to graduate. The fifth assessment required for graduation may include a Career and Technical Education Endorsement. The student's diploma will contain a technical education endorsement.

The 4+1 pathway option is effective beginning with students who first entered grade 9 in September 2011 and thereafter, or who are otherwise eligible to receive a high school diploma in June 2015 and thereafter.

- **MOUS**—Microsoft Certifications in Word, Access, Excel and PowerPoint, Word Expert, Excel Expert, and Outlook
- **Computer Graphics**—Adobe Certifications in Photoshop, Illustrator, Flash, InDesign
- **Hospitality & Tourism**—ServSafe Certification—The ServSafe Certificate of Achievement is accredited by the National Restaurant Association and is used throughout the United States. The program covers five key areas: basic food safety, personal hygiene, cross-contamination & allergens, time & temperature, and cleaning & sanitation. Most of our students work part-time in restaurants in town such as Burger King, McDonalds, Tim Hortons, etc. the ServSafe certification would give them an “edge” when applying for such jobs
- **BEEP—Certificate of Employability**—students must have an overall average of 90% in BEEP class and not miss more than 5 unexcused absences—this certificate is issued by the Niagara Frontier Industry Education Council

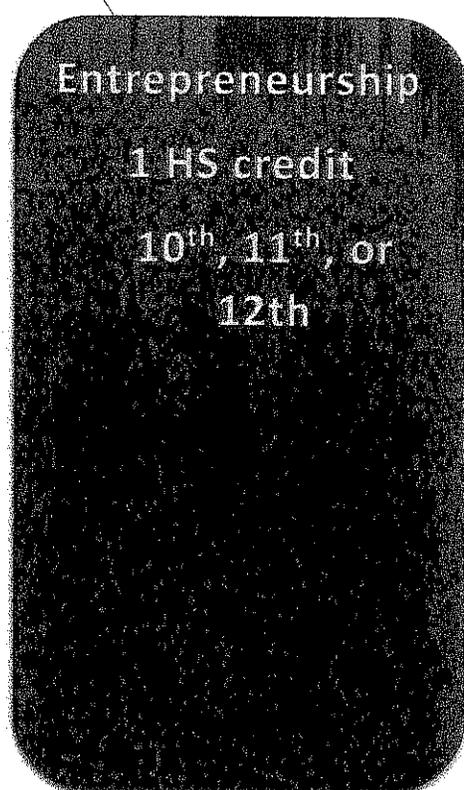
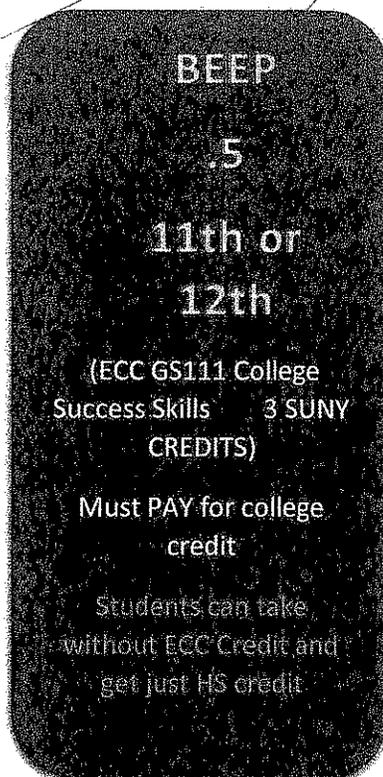
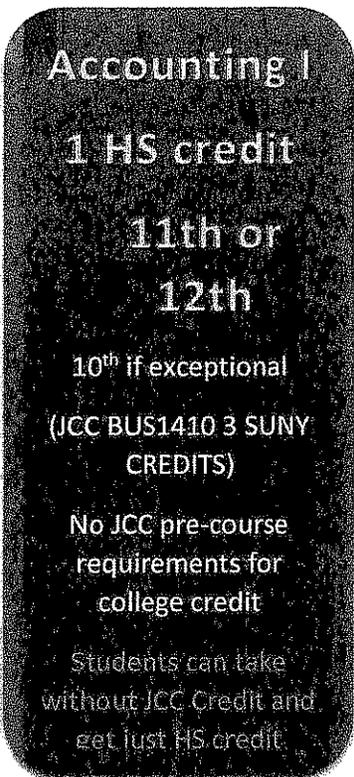
